THE BOTTOM LINE

Mike Elko's turnaround of Duke in just one season is nothing short of remarkable. After just five wins across the last two seasons, the Blue Devils have a chance to reach nine wins for the first time since 2014. Considering that the four losses this season were by a combined 16 points. Duke enters feeling confident led by quarterback Riley Leonard who leads the team in both passing and rushing. He has over 3,000 all-purpose yards and 31 total touchdowns this season. John Rhys Plumlee also led his team in passing and rushing this season and with Mikey Keene entering the transfer portal, Plumlee gets another shot in this game with the Knights. In addition to Plumlee, RJ Harvey and Isaiah Bowser pace a ground-and-pound Knight attack that reached over 3,000 combined rush yards.
