**THE BOTTOM LINE**

For Florida, it was a bit of a rocky road this season in Billy Napier's first year with a fair share of ups and downs. Quarterback Anthony Richardson declared for the draft and the backup is currently facing criminal charges, so that leaves either Jack Miller or Max Brown to take their first snaps of the season. The opposite was true for Oregon State, who put together their best season in a decade, finishing the season with a Civil War victory over rival Oregon. The Beavers offense is powered by a three-headed running back monster consisting of Damien Martinez, Jam Griffin, and Deshaun Fenwick. Martinez enters the bowl on a six game streak of 100 yards rushing or more. The Gators also ran the ball effectively this season and with questions at quarterback, both Montrell Johnson and Trevor Etienne will need to step up, especially against a strong run defense in Oregon State.
